BE IT REMEMBERED, THAT THERE CAME AND WAS HELD A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPTON, ILLINOIS at the VILLAGE HALL:

President Bornhoeft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Clerk Reyes called the roll noting a quorum present and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was held at the Village Hall.

Consideration and Approval of the minutes from the meeting May 9, 2022. Motion by Trustee Adams, second by Trustee King. Motion approved by unanimous voice vote.

Consideration and approval of payment of Bills. Motion by Trustee Adams, second by Trustee Gonzalez to approve the bills. Roll call as follows White, King, Gonzalez, Schneckloth and Adams: "Aye". Motion approved.

Acknowledgement of Visitors Who Desire to Address the Board. No visitors in attendance.

Consideration and Approval of the road patches from Elite Concrete. Trustee King made the motion, second by Trustee Gonzalez to approve the patches. Roll call as follows White, King, Gonzalez, Schneckloth and Adams: "Aye". Motion approved.

Consideration and Approval of the pieces needed for the park. Trustee King made the motion, second by Trustee Gonzalez to purchase the parts needed to complete Munson Park. Roll call as follows White, King, Gonzalez, Schneckloth and Adams: "Aye". Motion approved.

Consideration and Approval of the blacktop quote from Bob's Blacktop. Trustee King made the motion, second by Trustee White to approve the work from Bob's. Roll call as follows White, King, Gonzalez, Schneckloth and Adams: "Aye". Motion approved.

Consideration and Approval of sending firefighters to IFSI Fire College. Chief Johnson stated that the last couple of years firefighters were not able to attend due to COVID. He would like to send a couple fire fighters to the training, money is in his budget. Motion made by Trustee King to send the firefighters to training, not to exceed \$2,000 for class, hotel and food, second by Trustee Adams. Roll call as follows White, King, Gonzalez, Schneckloth and Adams: "Aye". Motion approved.

NEW BUSINESS and Committee Reports.

Streets and Alleys: Trustee White will meet with a resident on 6th regarding dumping and condition of road.

Public Safety: absent, however, Trustee White stated that 3 firefighters passed their certification. Fire Station looks great.

Police Chief Report: nothing to report.

Fire Chief Report: nothing to report.

Finance: Trustee Adams spoke with First Midstate and Dave will be at the meeting on the 23rd of June to explain options. Historical Society would like to use the Village Hall to have a craft/vendor show in October, no objections from the board.

Insurance and Code Enforcement: Trustee King would like to get with the department heads on what their needs are for the loan.

Public Works: Trustee Schneckloth had nothing to report

Supervisor Report: Supervisor Toalson is working on a job description for the open full time position.

Parks and Heritage Center: Trustee Gonzalez nothing to report.

Clerk: sent the Video Gaming ordinance to the businesses that have them.

Village Attorney Report: Attorney Holmes reported that the City of Moline hires the Junk/Weed ordinance to a contractor. President Bornhoeft, Trustee King and Attorney Holmes to set a time to meet with Mr. Grafton in regards to animal control.

President's Report and Comments: President Bornhoeft would like on the next agenda to address grass clippings in the streets, it is home owners responsibility, also many complaints about parking in yards; received complaints about the cemetery and trash being thrown around, President Bornhoeft spoke with Township and they have a new crew, it seems to be looking much better. President Bornhoeft

would like Supervisor Toalson to mark out the areas in town that were suggested by Officer Patterson for street lights.

Trustee King motioned to adjourn, second by Trustee White. Motion passed by unanimous vote to adjourn.
