President Christopher Bornhoeft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Clerk Bergeson called the roll noting a quorum was present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was held at the Village Hall.

Approval of the Meeting Minutes of June 22, 2026. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee White seconded by Trustee Johnson. Approved with unanimous voice vote. Klouser absent.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills. Motion to approve payment of bills made by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee Culver. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson, Gonzalez and Adams: "Aye". Absent: Klouser. Motion passed.

Visitors who wish to address the Board (3-minute time limit). Sam Colburn addressed the council and stated that everyone in the neighborhood signed a petition in favor of Andreyas's woodworking. Mr. Colburn also stated that if the board is going to make her have a business license, the neighborhood took up a collection to pay for it.

Acknowledgment of correspondence from residents. Tom McKay mailed a letter regarding the dirt track in his neighbor's yard. They are revving bikes all day and night. Police have been called;

Discussion, Consideration and Approval of the Special Use Permit for Andrey Stouffer. A zoning hearing was held on June 29, 2026 at 6:00PM at the Village Hall. It was recommended that the special permit be issued with conditions to keep the wood working within the constraints of the garage. The front of the property will show no signs of a business being operated. Motion by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Adams to approve the special use permit. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson, Gonzalez and Adams: "Aye". Absent: Klouser. Motion passed.

Discussion, Consideration and Approval of the quote from McClintock for replacement of the sinkholes next to road in Heritage Center. Public Works Director Eric Toalson absent. Trustee White made a motion to get two (2) additional quotes, seconded by Trustee Gonzalez. Motion approved by unanimous voice vote. Gonzalez absent.

Discussion, Consideration and Approval regarding raffle item for Hampton Days 2026. Trustee Gonzalez made a motion to approve the purchase of a Blackstone Grill and meat bundle from Cattlemen's meat market in the amount of \$500.00, seconded by Trustee Johnson. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson, Gonzalez and Adams: "Aye". Absent: Klouser. Motion passed.

Streets and Alleys: Trustee Culver spoke with MidAmerican and they cannot put maps together for the streetlight project. Trustee Klouser to go to county and get a map to mark out the need and placement of streetlights.

Public Safety: Trustee Johnson no updates.

Sheriff: Deputy nothing to report.

Fire Rescue Chief Report: Chief Manion everybody is doing a great job.

Finance: Trustee Adams asked that everyone look at the new IML Review page 21 there is revenue projections.

Administration, Insurance, and Code Enforcement: Trustee Klouser absent.

Public Works: Trustee White asked about the sewer bill from EM, Clerk Bergeson stated that EM is coming out to calibrate it.
